Stardust: Here's mine. (Stardust hands her paperwork to Galexie.)

Galexie: (Galexie looks over the papers.) Seems your paperwork is in order. You need to join the new recruits over there. Captain Comet will be arriving soon.

Sparky: Thank you.

Stardust: Yes, thank you. (Sparky and Stardust move toward the recruits.)

Twink: Ah, more newbies.

Sparky: Newbie? What's that?

- Captain: You are all shining just fine. (Turning to Sparky.) What about you, son? Let's see what you've got.
- Sparky: Yes, sir. (Sparky steps forward to attempt to shine.) **FX:5, Split:66**
- Captain: Where's your shine, kid?
- Sparky: I've always had a little trouble with my shine, sir. But, I promise to work hard to improve.
- Captain: You will have to improve, son. There are no stars in Star Power Training School that do not shine. In fact, I'm looking for the brightest star of all to lead the way in a special mission. I need the brightest star in the universe. Miss Lexie, help these new recruits stow their gear. I will return in 01:00 hours to begin class.
- Gallexie: Yes, sir! Attention! (All the star recruits salute the Captain, then the Captain exits.) You can stow your gear over there. I will return with the Captain. Get ready to work. (Gallexie exits.)
- Alpha: (Sparky tries to lay his gear down.) Hey, that's my spot. Move it. (Alpha and Sirius push Sparky then, Sparky moves to a different place.)
- Sirius: Yeah, move over.
- Stardust: Don't mind those guys, Sparky. Just ignore them. They're just bullies.
- Sparky: I don't blame them. It's so embarrassing that I can never shine when I need to. I try hard, Stardust. I think...shine...shine...shine. But, nothing happens.
